

WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL – WARM AND SAFE WILTSHIRE PROJECT

Wiltshire County Council is running the Warm and Safe Wiltshire Project in conjunction with the Centre for Sustainable Energy and Wiltshire Fire and Rescue. As part of this service the Council is able to offer free energy related advice and support to all Wiltshire residents. Although the service is open to everyone, we can provide more in-depth support, including home visits for more vulnerable residents whose health may be effected by a cold house and who may be struggling with heating, energy bills, damp and mould etc.

Specifically, the Warm and Safe Wiltshire Project can:

- Provide help and advice relating to insulation, heating and draft proofing.
- Provide guidance on heating systems and controls.
- Help identify issues relating to damp and condensation.
- Provide advice on understanding fuel bills.
- Give help with switching energy suppliers and fuel tariffs to keep bills affordable.
- Offer debt advice relating to fuel bills.
- Identify available grants and schemes for home improvements that would lead to increased energy efficiency and/or improved well being.
- A comprehensive home fire safety service.
- Provide advice guides and factsheets.
