Did you know that there are many different species which perform different roles?

Dr Shepherd says this activity can be carried out at any time of the year - you can repeat from time to time. Farmers might like to take up to 5 samples from different parts of a field and samples from arable fields would be great. You can help build up some serious scientic data by taking part in this, so a better understanding can be developed of what soil management best promotes healthy, living soil . Children love taking part in this activity - a good learning experience during lockdown, and exciting for adults too!
